

#### Message from the Candidates

With new electoral boundaries and no incumbent candidate, the 2024 BC Provincial Election presents tremendous opportunity for the residents of the North Westside. We are very happy to share a short statement from the candidates within our district.



Stephen Johnston - Unaffiliated

My name is Stephen Johnston, and I'm excited to take this opportunity to introduce myself as your MLA candidate for West Kelowna-Peachland! As a lifelong Westsider, I have deep roots in our community—my parents still live in the same home in Rose Valley where I was raised. After graduating from Mount Boucherie Secondary, I married my high school sweetheart, Leah, and we've been blessed to raise our two wonderful children right here in West Kelowna.

Over the past six years, I have had the privilege of serving as both a West Kelowna City Councillor and a Director with the RDCO, earning top votes in the last two elections. I am recognized as a trusted leader with a strong record of integrity and a deep commitment to the people and communities I serve. As a lifelong resident of the Westside, I have spent decades building meaningful relationships across the riding and region.

In West Kelowna–Peachland, securing a second power line is critical for ensuring the safety and resilience of our communities. The region faces inadequate infrastructure and is in dire need of investment, especially in our road networks. This includes upgrades to Highway 97 interchanges, overpasses, and intersections, improvements to the Westbank Town Centre couplet, and substantial repairs to Westside Road—one of the most dangerous roads in Canada. From crack filling to repaying and addressing hazardous sections, these roads require urgent attention and funding.

The North Westside is currently undergoing a governance study and deserves greater focus, as it is often overlooked within the riding. Many residents receive services from the RDNO while paying taxes to the RDCO, a mismatch that impacts services like healthcare—residents contribute to the Central Okanagan Regional Hospital District, yet most rely on Vernon's hospital, which is closer and more accessible.

We must also address the long, unsafe commutes children from the North Westside endure, spending hours on dangerous roads just to get to school. It is essential to consider whether adjusting the regional district boundaries to better align with service areas would serve our communities more effectively. The completion of the governance study will provide much-needed clarity on this issue.

#### Krystal Smith - BC NDP



I was born, raised and educated in the Okanagan. It's where my friends and family are, so the area is very dear to me.

I've always worked to help improve people's lives. One of the most important issues in West Kelowna-Peachland is the cost of housing. Everyone deserves a safe place to live. The BC NDP plan is bringing housing prices down in the lower mainland and it will make a difference here too.

We're building homes and strengthening services to tackle homelessness and prevent people from losing their homes in the first place. Today thousands of people have a home with supports, because the BC NDP created 6,000 supportive homes since 2017. Over 2,700 more on the way.

More than 650 new treatment beds opened across BC and we're building new treatment facilities across the province.

We're acting to fight crime and keep people safe by attacking root causes and it's making a difference. We've hired over 250 police officers and launched new specialized teams to go after gangs, guns and drugs.

The last few years have been challenging, and we are delivering supports. i.e. we doubled the exemption threshold for the Employer Health Tax - a big break for small- and medium-sized business and now 90% of businesses pay no EHT.

And we're taking better care of this place we love, building a clean economy with good-paying, local jobs. CleanBC is one of the most ambitious climate plans on the continent.

I am very concerned that if John Rustad and the Conservatives are elected, they will undo all the progress that the BC NDP has made. That is why I am running. I want to give people an option other than John Rustad.


